3. I agree, in principal, that a reasonable fee should be allowed for undertaking this work. However, this work should be classed as preparation work rather than perusal work. Also, as with any account prepared in terms of the Table of Fees in Schedule 3 of the Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Regulations 1996, only fees for the actual time taken to perform a piece of work should be contained therein.
