7 Minutes of Admissions were granted during the trial cutting court time by many days.

Auditor states that the inordinate number of Crown productions was an extraordinary feature of the case. They required careful perusal, consideration and analysis and justified a separate preparation fee.

NB: Counsel took a Note of Objections re this decision which was heard in Glasgow Sheriff Court on 02.08.90 – Sheriff repelled counsel's motion and upheld the Auditor's decision.
