Trial took place in September 1990 and lasted 11 days.

Indictment contained one charge of rape and murder of 10 year old girl.

131 Crown witnesses.

46 documentary productions.

101 labelled productions.

SC claimed £500 per day. Board offered £400 per day. The prescribed Glasgow fee was then £322.50.

Assisting JC.

SC involved in considerable research $-1^{\rm st}$ murder trial in Scotland where DNA genetic profiling test was used by the prosecution therefore extensive forensic enquiries had had to be made.

Important questions of admissibility of evidence arose during trial.

SC did not charge any separate preparation fee.

Accused convicted of murder, acquitted of rape and received life sentence.

FEATURES

Auditor allowed enhanced fee due to gravity of the two charges, duration of the trial, complexity of the forensic evidence and the additional time and research required.
