Trial was still ongoing when taxation held on 06.07.93 – had been running for 38 days.

The Board did not dispute the actual 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours preparation claimed by JC but did dispute the amount sought by JC (i.e. £2,800 = approx. £56 p.h).

20,000 pages of documentary productions.

Crown case was still in a state of preparation and was "being put together" as the case proceeded – this required more frequent consultations with the accused.

Auditor persuaded that the starting point when considering the fee for preparation here should be the "junior counsel Edinburgh" rate.

Auditor stated that there were exceptional circumstances surrounding this complex case. Auditor arrived at preparation rate by taking the sum of £242.50 less £80.75 = £161.75 and adding an element for exceptional preparation.
