

LEGAL AID (SCOTLAND) ACT 1986

DETERMINATION BY SCOTTISH MINISTERS

The Scottish Ministers make the following determination in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 4(3)(e) of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986(a).

Commencement and interpretation

1. —(1) This determination will come into effect on 1st April 2018.
- (2) In this determination “the Money Advice Service” means the Money Advice Service, a limited company, number 07172704.

Payment of monies from Money Advice Service to the Board

2. When, from time to time beginning with 1st April 2018 and ending on 31st March 2019, monies are paid by the Money Advice Service to the Scottish Legal Aid Board for the purpose of making grants under section 4A of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986(b), those monies shall be paid into the Scottish Legal Aid Fund.
